

## Students can benefit from the digital equipment of nearby schools in order to take university exams online

As a response to the **National Alliance of Student Organizations in Romania's (ANOSR's) recommendations**, the Ministry of Education and Research has sent a note to the School Inspectorates on the 19<sup>th</sup> of May, which addresses the issue of university students who do not have a computer connected to the Internet or equipped with a webcam, necessary in order to take online exams.

Thus, **students who do not have the necessary digital means can benefit from the endowment of the primary or secondary school within their area of residence**, by submitting an application form to the management of the most nearby school, based on their ID and up-to-date student card.

According to the Ministry of Education and Research, the use of digital equipment is possible inside the school, in compliance with all the sanitary and hygiene-related rules established within the educational unit.

**We encourage students who find themselves in this situation to make use of this possibility** and, at the same time, to follow the hygienic-sanitary norms for their own benefit and that of those around them.

**ANOSR** maintains its **position** on **this academic year's admission process to higher education** and supports the implementation of similar measures for candidates, in order to submit their applications and take the online admission exams.
