

Education – A priority in the agenda of political parties?

Local and parliamentary elections for the next term are an opportunity to set goals for higher education for the next period, as well as to find out the priorities on the educational agenda of the political parties for 2020–2024.

For this reason, on Monday, August 17, the National Alliance of Student Organizations in Romania (ANOSR) invited the parliamentary parties to a debate with students participating in the General Assembly of the federation, which will take place on Saturday, August 29, 2020, starting at 14: 00, in the Summer Garden of the Students' Culture House in Bucharest.

In the untimely context caused by the emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic at international level, it is undeniable that education is and will continue to be affected. That is why concrete and feasible solutions are needed, which can reduce the negative impact generated and which can maximize the results obtained by the main beneficiaries, the students. Therefore, we consider it essential to establish a clear and assumed vision of education as a national priority, in order to unify the attitude of the political class in a unitary way and to outline a future decision-making coherence.

During the event, we intend to initiate a constructive dialogue on issues of educational interest between political parties and to debate a series of guidelines, able to involve university communities and gradually improve the quality of life of students, with the installation of a new legislature for the future term.

The General Assembly will take place between August 27–30, 2020 and will bring together student leaders from across the country, both physically and online. Within this, the steps of the federation from the beginning of the mandate will be analyzed and until now, the current Governing Board will present its activity carried out during the mandate, afterwards, a new Governing Board will be elected for the term 2020–2021.

ANOSR has always campaigned for a quality educational process, investments in education and optimal conditions for students, so we demand responsibility from the invited political parties, in order to see what they focus on, in order to ensure a quality education system .

"In these moments of uncertainty we need a responsible political class, which should give the necessary importance to investing in the education system, this being the only chance for the development of Romanian society. Thus, given that the local and parliamentary elections are coming, which will have a significant impact on everyone, we want a dialogue with the representatives of the political parties in which we will present our objectives, objectives that we want to be taken over in the parties' agenda." – Petrișor-Laurențiu ȚUCĂ, president of the National Alliance of Student Organizations in Romania(ANOSR)
